

BASIC HANDGUN OUTDOOR RANGE INSTRUCTIONS

Bring your eye and ear protection, if you have them. Otherwise, they will be provided. Prescription glasses or sunglasses may generally be used as eye protection. Dress appropriately for the weather conditions. You may wish to bring a hat or ball-cap for the live fire training exercise. I recommend avoiding wearing shorts, tank tops, collared shirts or low cut shirts (there will be **hot casings** during the live fire). The spent (and hot) shell casings tend to find the way to exposed, sensitive skin areas, such as underneath shirts) which can be very hot, or even burn the skin. Please dress accordingly.

The location of the classroom training facility is: **2270 Nicolaus Rd #109, Lincoln, CA 95648**. Please refer to the detailed driving directions below. **Be sure to bring cash for the \$20.00 range fee.**

We will begin at the classroom training facility, and after some classroom instruction and lessons, we will drive to the outdoor range for live fire (just about 10 minutes north of the classroom). Please dress accordingly for the weather. You may wish to bring some bottled water and snacks (there is a convenience store in the same lot). If you have a comfortable folding chair, you may wish to bring that as well, for the outdoor range. The range can be a bit dusty at times. In the winter months, it can be muddy. In the winter, I recommend bringing a change of shoes, and you probably want to wear some old boots or shoes, and change them after shooting, and before re-entering your vehicle. Shooting is a sporting event. I cannot stress the importance of dressing appropriately.

Our Basic Handgun course includes the following: Use of a 22 caliber rim-fire semi- automatic pistol, ammunition, target, safety equipment and training materials.

If you wish to bring your own handgun(s) for the outdoor course, and it is larger than 22 caliber rim-fire, you must bring your own ammunition. In the event that you need to reschedule, please give as much notice as possible, and refer to the class schedule on the website at www.BestHandgunTraining.com .

THIS COURSE IS WEATHER PERMITTING, AND MAY BE SUBJECT TO RESCHEDULE WITH INCLEMENT WEATHER.

The training facility is located at the corner of Nicolaus Road and Lakeside Drive, and also near the intersection of Nicolaus Road and Joiner Parkway. The best entrance to the parking lot is through the Chevron (Tower Mart) gas station entrance. We are just to the right of the Karen's Little Cafe.

There is plenty of free parking available. Please do not park directly in front of the storefront businesses, as mandated by our lease and also with respect to our neighboring businesses.

There are plenty of restaurants nearby, including Subway and Karen's Little Café. There are other restaurants and fast food establishments nearby, within driving distance of a few miles.

The Basic Pistol course includes the following: Use of a 22 caliber rim-fire semi- automatic pistol, ammunition, target, and training materials.

If you bring a firearm to any course, be sure it is UNLOADED and in a locked container (ammunition stored separately). **Do NOT bring in a firearm, unless instructed to do so.**

During classroom and range instruction, the phone is turned off, sent directly to the answering machine. It is a landline and does not receive text messages.

*******IMPORTANT DRIVING DIRECTIONS FOR YOUR HANDGUN TRAINING CLASS*******

Our street address is: **2270 Nicolaus Rd, Lincoln, CA 95648**. Outdated (or not recently updated) GPS devices may take you through town if you do not follow these directions.

From I-80, exit to Northbound Hwy 65, (towards Marysville). Go past Rocklin, and past Thunder Valley Casino. After you pass Ferrari Ranch Road, you will come to a traffic signal on the highway. This is Nelson Lane. Turn right on Nelson, and go to the stop sign. Turn right at the stop sign (Nicolaus Road). Go to the second stop sign, and turn left on Lakeside Dr, and then immediately into the Chevron gas station parking lot. Drive beyond the gas station, and you will see our classroom training facility, to the right of Karen's Little Cafe.

If you are bringing a gun to the range, please leave all firearms in your vehicle until we arrive at the shooting range. Do NOT bring them into the classroom, unless instructed to do so.

Be sure to transport any firearms in accordance to state law (UNLOADED, and locked in a secure container) and have the ammunition out of the locking container to be safe.
